### **McNutt new at Tomorrow's Voices**

Lexi McNutt is the new executive director of Tomorrow's Voices.

McNutt also is new to the nonprofit world and said she is excited about the opportunity to work with an organization that helps engage and educate the community's youth about the world around them.

McNutt is an attorney and has lived in Aspen since 2001. Prior to moving to Aspen she practiced corporate law in New York City and Boulder.

Tomorrow's Voices is a nonpartisan, educational organization dedicated to cultivating responsible citizenship and ethical leadership in the youth of the Roaring Fork Valley by fostering the skills and knowledge necessary to discover their own voice.

Tomorrow's Voices provides dual credit high school classes to students in the Roaring Fork Valley; consults with schools in the Roaring Fork Valley to develop curriculum to address educational needs; and hosts its own public forum series.

Tomorrow's Voices fall classes started in September with 55 students from Glenwood Springs to Aspen. This semester's course, "Systems of American Democracy," is an enrichment to the conventional social studies curriculum. Some of the topics that are covered in a lecture and small group discussion format include social issues such as euthanasia, efficacy of foreign aid, neo-conservatism, Arab-Israeli politics, and immigration.
